Each regular and life member is entitled to one vote at all membership meetings. A family membership will allow three (3) members of a family to vote (voting members must be specified on the membership application). If more than three family members want to be eligible to vote, an individual membership must be purchased for them.

Voting by proxy is prohibited in non-profit associations where membership is individual, personal, and non-transferable. A proxy vote permits someone else to execute your ballot either by letting them choose who or what you are voting for or by having them handle your ballot (mailing it for you or bringing it to the voting meeting). Voting by letter ballots will be allowed if the ballot is received before the date of the meeting.

A member may vote in one of two ways: 1) **Hand carries their own ballot** to the meeting, or 2) **Mail in their ballot**. Mailed in ballots must be in a separate envelope for each voting member. (Family members may send in their ballots in one envelope.) The name(s) of the voting member(s) and "ballot" must be written on the envelope.

If these instructions are not followed the ballots will be voided.

C) Must provide a separate arena for lunging and warmups. D) Courses must be changed and be new daily. E) Divisions must have a minimum of three (3) over fence classes to be given an "A" rating. F) All divisions (excluding equitation classes) must be held over two (2) days to be given an "A" rating.
